

Travis Cloer - Midtown Men - Bio

Travis is excited to join The Midtown Men! After sharing the stage with the other Men in the Broadway company of JERSEY BOYS, he went on to star as Frankie Valli in the Las Vegas company & is the longest running actor to consecutively play the part. The show played in Vegas for 8 1/2 years, closing in 2016 after 3,279 performances & is in the books as “the longest running Broadway show to play the Strip in Las Vegas history”. He was called “one of Vegas’ most accomplished showmen” by the LV SUN, “Terrific & awe-inspiring” by BroadwayWorld.com, & Metro UK said “he melts hearts with his voice”.

You can see him as Frankie Valli in the Will Farrell & Mark Wahlberg film The Other Guys, as well as on many TV appearances including The Doctors, The Queen Latifah Show, & The 2010 Daytime EMMY Awards celebrating the legendary Dick Clark. He has performed concerts as a soloist with the Abilene Philharmonic & the Las Vegas Philharmonic, & is one of the leading guest artists in the cruising industry having worked with NCL, Holland America, Celebrity, & Viking, to name a few.

As a recording artist, Travis can be heard on “SEASONS Greetings: A JERSEY BOYS Christmas” where he worked directly with original FOUR SEASONS member & composer Bob Gaudio. He also has released two solo records. On “Setting the Standard” he delivers his favorite songs from the Great American Songbook & was called “classy, jazzy, & Rat Pack smooth” by the LV Review Journal. In 2015 he released his fully orchestrated Holiday record “Christmas at My Place” to stellar reviews. It includes his new, original Holiday hit,

“(Baby, it’s Cold) Under the Mistletoe”. Celebrity journalist Robin Leach said, “If this is Christmas at Travis’ place, I’ll don a Santa suit, come down his chimney on Christmas Eve and stay through Boxing Day!” He has performed both records live in concert to sell out crowds.
